

Minnesota Beef Expo - Bovine Tuberculosis

ALL CATTLE (Sale and Junior Show)

Cattle from Minnesota

No individual TB tests required; unless from the Management zone located in the northwest part of Minnesota. Producers in the smaller Management Zone will continue slightly modified testing and movement requirements. For a map of the Management zone, go to www.bah.state.mn.us/

Cattle from outside Minnesota. Must meet the Minnesota Importation requirements.

- A. Cattle from states other than Minnesota must meet the importation requirements of their state of origin if they are returning.
 - B. Certificate of Veterinary Inspection must list the Minnesota State Fair as consignee. Exhibitors should bring duplicates of their health papers along with the originals.
