Minnesota Beef Expo Awards 2025 Minnesota Youth Beef Experience Program Achievement Award to Riley Rickford

St. Paul, Minn. – Riley Rickford of Barnesville, Minn. was awarded the Minnesota Youth Beef Experience Program (MYBEP) Achievement Award and received a custom belt buckle and a \$1,000 premium sponsored by the Maurice Grogan family.

In 2024, the Minnesota Beef Expo awarded 11 heifers to deserving youth through the Minnesota Youth Beef Experience Program (MYBEP). Each recipient was selected based on their passion for agriculture, commitment to raising a heifer, financial need and willingness to learn. Recipients were responsible for raising, breeding and maintaining records on the care of the animal, while providing progress reports to their mentor, breed representative and Minnesota Beef Expo staff. Donors of the heifers served as mentors to MYBEP recipients. To date, the MYBEP program has awarded 180 heifers. The 2024 MYBEP heifer recipients were:
