# DONOR INFORMATION

### DONOR RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Provide requested information to Minnesota Beef Expo staff and respond to inquiries in a timely manner.
- Review and score all recipient applications.
- Transport the heifer to the Minnesota Beef Expo. Donors are responsible for the heifer during the event unless other arrangements are made with the recipient.
- Attend the donor and recipient meeting during the Minnesota Beef Expo.
- Transfer ownership to the recipient prior to, or shortly after, the 2026 Minnesota Beef Expo.
- Serve as a mentor to the recipient throughout the year, offering guidance, answering questions and providing support as needed.

## TIMELINE:

- **April 1:** commit to being a donor
- **July 1:** send donor information to Karmen Sperr
  - Things to include:
    - Short bio
    - Breed Association
    - Donor name(s)
    - Farm name
    - Farm address
    - Phone number(s)
    - Email address(es)
    - Farm logo and/or family photo
- **Sept. 1:** send heifer information to Karmen Sperr
  - Things to include:
    - Animal name
    - Registration number
    - Date of Birth
    - Sire and Dam
    - A copy of the registration papers, if available
    - Stalling preference
- **Sept. 14 – Oct. 1:** Review and judge recipient applications
- **Oct. 15 – 18:** 2026 Minnesota Beef Expo
  - Thursday, Oct. 15 – Friday, Oct. 16: Check-in
  - Friday, Oct. 16: Donor and recipient meeting
  - Saturday, Oct. 17: Heifer presentation
- **October 2026 – October 2027:** Be available to mentor and advise the recipient. Review their quarterly reports.
- **Oct. 21 – 24, 2027:** 2027 Minnesota Beef Expo
  - Saturday, Oct. 23: 2026 MYBEP Showmanship and Interviews. MYBEP Achievement Award winner will be announced that evening.
